#### **OFFICIAL MINUTES**

## **Regular Public Meeting December 16, 2008**

#### I. Call To Order

The workshop portion of the meeting held by the Bradley Beach Board of Education was called to order at 7:02 p.m. by President Charette at the school, 515 Brinley Avenue, Bradley Beach, NJ.

#### II. **Open Public Meetings Act**

In accordance with the Open Public Meetings Act, notice of this meeting has been given to the designated newspapers, The Asbury Park Press and The New Coaster, and posted in the school in a place reserved for this kind of notice.

#### Superintendent's Report

Dr. Turner began the workshop session with an introduction of Ms. Kimberly Meckes, the district's music teacher, and five students that make up part of the flute ensemble. The flute ensemble played various holiday songs for the Board and members of the public. After the musical performance, Dr. Turner went over his agenda items, in particular the policies that were up for first reading, the appointment of Patty Velazquez to provide teaching services for evening classes of English as a Second Language for Spanish-Speaking Parents, and the five-year preschool program plan. Dr. Turner indicated that the State has mandated full-day high quality preschool (six hour day) for all 3 and 4-year old children in district factor group districts A and B, all 3 and 4-year old children in CD districts where 40% or more of their children are eligible for free and reduced lunch, and for 3 and 4-year old children on a per pupil basis for children eligible for free and reduced lunch in all other districts. Dr. Turner informed the Board that based on the 2008/2009 ASSA, which was completed in 2007/2008, the district has a 39.5% overall at risk population. Dr. Turner informed the Board that a sub committee of the Board met on December 8<sup>th</sup> to discuss the funding issues, the curriculum and the program plan.

Afterwards, Mr. Tonzola reviewed his agenda items. Mr. Tonzola informed the Board that on December 8<sup>th</sup> the Senate Education Committee released S-1861, which would move April's school board member elections to the November general election. The bill would also eliminate the vote on

school budgets that are below the state imposed tax levy caps. In addition, it would move the public vote on second ballot questions for local spending above state caps to the November general election. At the last Monmouth County School Business Officials meeting the Executive County Business Administrator said that this bill is on a fast track to the full senate.

On a unanimous voice vote the workshop portion of the meeting adjourned at 7:54 p.m.
