Mr. Majka began the workshop session by going over his agenda items with the Board.

Mr. Tonzola stated that the general fund budget will be increasing to \$7,141,640 and that the general fund tax levy will be increasing by \$325,109 to \$5,425,641. Mr. Tonzola also stressed to the Board that this is a tentative budget and that the district can still make changes up until the public hearing on March 26th.

After going over the budget and tax levy with the Board, Mr. Tonzola went over the remaining agenda items.

Mr. Migdon wished to thank Mrs. Betty Slocum for her generous donation and read her letter to the entire Board.
