The workshop portion of the meeting held by the Bradley Beach Board of Education was called to order at 7:02 p.m. by President Franks at the school, 515 Brinley Avenue, Bradley Beach, NJ.

### IV. <u>Discussion Items</u> – Update on District Goals – Dr. Stephen Wisniewski

## Superintendent's Report

Dr. Franks began the meeting by asking for a moment to remember Governor Murphy's first anniversary issuing the order to close schools due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Dr. Franks wanted this moment to recognize all individuals affected by the pandemic. Dr. Franks then turned the meeting over to Dr. Wisniewski. Before going over his agenda items, Dr. Wisniewski wanted to first thank the Visiting Nurse Association for the relationship to help get those staff members, who wish to get vaccinated, scheduled. Dr. Wisniewski then gave an update on the district goals: developing multiple scenarios for possible school closing and re-openings throughout the year and how the plans will be communicated to parents; address student growth and areas of loss through the creation of additional district data points, and share the results to the Board of Education, families, and community; continue professional development for staff to support the effective and accessible use of technology in virtual and in-person learning environments; incorporate varied communication methods for all families; and increase outreach efforts for parents/families with communication barriers.

After discussing the district goals, Dr. Wisniewski reviewed his agenda items with the Board, particularly the personnel and policy resolutions.

Dr. Franks then turned the meeting over to Mr. Tonzola. Before going over his agenda resolutions, Mr. Tonzola reminded the Board to complete their mandated training before December 31, 2021. Mr. Tonzola also updated the Board on the financial disclosure application. Mr. Tonzola then went over the tentative budget with the Board. Mr. Tonzola stated that the general fund budget would be decreasing by 1.68%, or \$128,408. Mr. Tonzola indicated that the Board would be increasing the general fund tax levy by 2% to \$6,446,186. Mr. Tonzola informed the Board that although this year's budget was in balance and without any staff or program cuts, the following three fiscal years, 2023-2025 budgets will be challenging to balance due to the continued reduction in state aid and the inability to generate an excess surplus in the preceding fiscal years. Mr. Tonzola also reviewed the tax rate and the tax rate's effect on an average residential assessed home in Bradley Beach. Mr. Tonzola stated that the budget tonight is tentative, and that the district can still make changes until the public hearing on April 27, 2021. After going over the budget and tax levy with the Board, Mr. Tonzola went over the remaining agenda items.

On a unanimous voice vote the workshop portion of the meeting adjourned at 8:42 p.m.
