



## **Creating a Strategic Plan for the Bradley Beach School District**

### **Mission Statement**

### **Session 2**

#### **Developing a Vision for the Bradley Beach School District**

On January 10, 2023, Bradley Beach School District administrators, Board of Education members, staff, parents, community members, and a student, thirty-six (36) in all, came together for the second strategic planning meeting. The topic for the second meeting was focused on developing a vision and initiatives, toward achieving that vision, for the Bradley Beach School District. The meeting began with a welcome and introduction by Board President, Elizabeth Franks. Facilitators Mary Ann Friedman and Michelle Kennedy, from New Jersey School Boards Association (NJSBA), were introduced and provided an overview of the strategic planning process and the focus for the evening's activity.

We reviewed the consensus process utilized in strategic planning. The topic for the evening focused on creating a shared vision for the Bradley Beach School District. Participants were asked to picture themselves, having been away from the district for 5 years, returning to Bradley Beach and seeing their school on the cover of TIME magazine. The article is about Schools that Succeed. In addition to the current programs already in place in Bradley Beach, what programs/services/curriculum/student outcomes/best practices/facilities would you expect to see in your schools that are succeeding? Participants were encouraged to think "big picture."

Participants gathered in randomly assigned groups, six groups, to develop a shared vision and initiatives. The small groups reviewed the outcomes from Meeting #1, strengths and challenges, and then began brainstorming on their vision for the district. After group discussion, each group identified their consensus points and presented those to the full group of meeting participants.
