Beginning with September 2011-2012 school year, our district has conscientiously implemented the requirements found in the Anti-Bullying Bill of Rights Act by:

Developing district HIB policies and procedures, appointing an anti-bullying specialist and coordinator, establishing a School Safety Team, conducting annual staff trainings, providing intensive anti-bullying programs for all students, observing the Week of Respect, conducting a district-wide school climate survey, creating anti-bullying art/slogans and observing of "Stomp Out Bullying Day".

During the first two years of implementation of the *Anti-Bullying Bill of Rights Act,* our school district has made progress in addressing and improving harassment, intimidation, and bullying and the school climate and culture by adhering to the district's HIB policy and promoting our vision for a positive school climate through on-going programming, discussion, and action.

While completing the Self-Assessment, we learned that our school district has demonstrated strengths in adhering to the HIB policy, conducting investigations and remediating situations, whether deemed a HIB incident or a conflict.
