

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Notice is hereby given that the Bradley Beach Board of Education will be receiving sealed bids at the board offices located at 515 Brinley Avenue, Bradley Beach New Jersey 07720, for the **Boiler Accessory Equipment Upgrades at Bradley Beach Elementary School**.

Bids must be submitted to the Bradley Beach Board of Education no later than **3:30 PM on Wednesday, February 11, 2026**. Bids are to be received at the Board Office. All bids will be opened and read to the public at that time by the School Business. No bid may be withdrawn for a period of sixty days from the opening of the bids.

Bid Documents have been prepared by the Board's Architect, Di Cara | Rubino Architects, with an office located at 35 Waterview Boulevard, Suite 303, Parsippany, NJ 07054, phone 973-256-0202. The bidding documents will be available on **Friday, January 16, 2026**. Prospective Bidders can preview and purchase the full bid package (cost \$50.00) directly from the Architect's website: www.dicarakarubinoplans.com. No documents shall be mailed, via US mail or overnight mail.

A Pre-Bid Meeting will be held on **Thursday, January 22, 2026, at 3:30 PM** at the Bradley Beach Elementary School, 515 Brinley Avenue, Bradley Beach, NJ 07720. All bidders are strongly encouraged to attend this Pre-Bid Meeting.

All bidders must use and complete all bid forms and must comply with every requirement contained in the instructions and specifications. Bids are to be marked in a sealed envelope and hand delivered, Sent UPS or Federal Express or similar courier service to Mr. David Tonzola, Bradley Beach Board of Education, 515 Brinley Avenue, Bradley Beach, NJ 07720, with the name of the project, "**Boiler Accessory Equipment Upgrades at Bradley Beach Elementary School**", plainly marked on the front of the envelope. Every bid must be accompanied by a certified check or a bid bond in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the bid, but not in excess of \$20,000.00.

All bidders and their subcontractors shall be registered with the New Jersey Department of Labor and Workforce Development, pursuant to the Public Works Contractor Registration Act, N.J.S.A. 34:11-56.48 et seq. All bids must be accompanied by a Certificate issued by the New Jersey Department of Labor and Workforce Development, pursuant to the Public Works Contractor Registration Act as to the Bidder and all subcontractors.

Pursuant to P.L. 2004 c.57, (N.J.S.A. 52:32-44) all bids must be accompanied by a New Jersey Business Registration Certificate issued by the New Jersey Department of Treasury, Division of Revenue. The Bidder must include with its bid its own Business Registration Certificate and that of all subcontractors.

Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:2-1 et seq., "The Law Against Discrimination" and Affirmative Action, N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 17:27-1 et seq.

No bidder who is on the State Treasurer's or the Federal Government's List of Debarred, Suspended or Disqualified Bidders shall be eligible to bid on this project.

Bidders are required to comply with the anti-discrimination requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:2-1 et seq., "The Law Against Discrimination", N.J.S.A. 10:5-1 et seq. and equal employment opportunity and affirmative action requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 17:27-1 et seq.

The Bradley Beach Board of Education reserves the right to reject any or all bids and waive any informality in the bidding process in accordance with the law if it is in the best interest of the Board of Education. The contract, if awarded, shall be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder whose bid is responsive in all material respects to the bid requirements. No bid shall be deemed accepted until the adoption of a formal resolution by the Bradley Beach Board of Education.
