Nature and Job Summary: Under the guidance of the Director of Special Services and Principal / Superintendent, the Special Education Teacher specializing in Autism Spectrum Disorders will be entrusted with designing and implementing individualized educational plans (IEPs) tailored to students with autism. This role involves creating an engaging, inclusive, and adaptive learning environment that caters to the unique needs of each student. The teacher will collaborate closely with parents, therapists, and other educational professionals to ensure a holistic and integrated approach to education. Emphasis will be on the application of evidence-based teaching strategies, including Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA), to promote students' academic, social, and life skills development.

Preference will be given to candidates with strong experience in special education, particularly with children on the autism spectrum, and a comprehensive understanding of behavior management principles.

This is a part time position.

Qualifications:

- Valid teaching certificate with an endorsement in Special Education from any state. If not from New Jersey, must be able to obtain NJ certification.
- Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA) certification is required.

- Demonstrated expertise in working with students with autism and implementing ABA techniques in educational settings.
- Excellent communication skills, with the ability to engage effectively with students, parents, and colleagues.
- Commitment to continuous professional development in special education practices and autism interventions.
- Required Criminal History Check.
- Provide proof of US citizenship or legal Resident Alien status by completing Federal Form I-9.
- Pass required State Mantoux/Tuberculin test and physical exam as required.
